# Day 1 B, L, D

We will start with the **Red Oak Vineyard** where you can taste wine while viewing the wine making process. Next, is **Door 44** where their mission is to create world-class quality wines, made from grapes grown here in their own vineyard. We'll make a stop at Door County's largest winery, the **Door Peninsula Winery**, where you will be able to taste from over 50 traditional grape wines, fruit wines and hard ciders while learning about this 45 year old business and its building, originally a schoolhouse from 1868. Dinner is at a local **Supper Club and includes a cocktail!** Enjoy an **evening learning about the doomed of Dooor County on a haunted Door County Tour**. Enjoy a **2 night stay at the down-to-earth waterfront resort, Rowleys Bay Resort**.

#### Day 2 B. D

Ride the ferry to **Washington Island**. Then relax and enjoy a **Tram Tour** of Washington Island. The local guide describes life on the Island, past and present. Learn about natural history, geology, settlement, economy and how the island today compares with years ago. The tour covers 15 miles and stops at four different locations. At the **Lautenbach's Orchard Winery** you'll discover 100 acres of fruit-laden orchards and vineyards. Enjoy the tastes of their labor with some samples! You have to love the **Harbor Ridge Winery** motto - "Solving the world's problems one sip at a time" and we will say cheers to that with some samples. Enjoy a traditional **Door County Fish Boil and listen to Peter Rowley tell you about the history of the area.** If you do not care for fish, no problems as there are other entrees and much more availble! This evening, gather around the fire and enjoy a S'more and More (beverage).

## Day 3 B

After breakfast we will depart Rowley's Bay. Just 2,500 miles northeast of Napa Valley you'll find the **Stone's Throw Winery** where they use Micro-Vinification to produce their wines. We will learn about that process while enjoying some samples! Our final winery is Wisconsin's oldest licensed winery, the **Von Stiehl Winery**, where they have 30 plus grape and fruit wines all housed in a Civil War-era building listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Enjoy the view of Lake Michigan and some samples! Return home exclaiming "Cheers to a Great Wine Weekend."
