Day 1 B, D

Enjoy a boxed breakfast as we make our way to the DoubleTree Hotel in Independence, OH for our first overnight and dinner.

Day 2 B, D

We'll check into the historic and posh Omni William-Penn Hotel, the place to stay in Pittsburgh. This evening we'll board the Explorer Riverboat for “An Intro to Innovation” Dinner Cruise. Known as a modern tech and robotics hub, the ‘Burgh’ has been in the vanguard of industrial reinvention for more than 250 years.

Day 3 B, D

Before leaving Pittsburgh, we will stop for a guided tour of the Nationality Rooms at the University of Pittsburgh's Cathedral of Learning, a dramatic Gothic Revival tower of carved Indiana limestone soaring 535 feet into the sky. We will learn about the traditions and daily life of the different ethnic groups that settled in Western Pennsylvania. Our final stop in Pittsburgh is the Soldiers & Sailors Memorial Hall & Museum that stands to honor veterans of all branches of service, from all generations and conflicts since 1910. Tonight, we will arrive in Hershey, PA and overnight at the Hershey Lodge. We know Hershey doesn't have a “P” in the name, but it does have perfect chocolate.

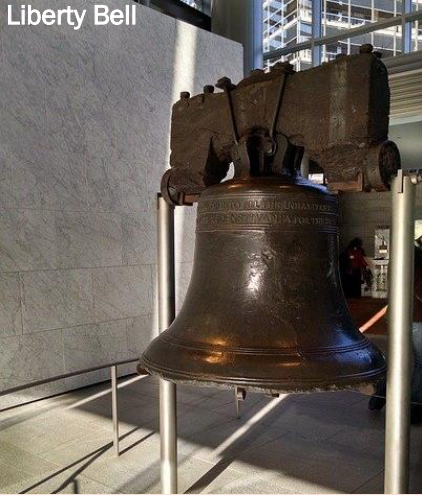

Tonight you will return home with perfectly pleasant memories of your vacation to explore the P's of Pennsylvania.

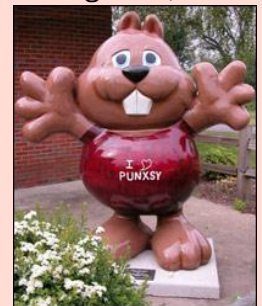
