Day 1 B, D

Enjoy breakfast “on the bus” at your leisure as a boxed breakfast is included. Relax, take in the view, and meet your fellow travelers. Late afternoon we’ll arrive in Maumee, OH for an included dinner and overnight at the Country Inn & Suites.

Day 2 B, D

Day 3 B, D

After **Dinner**, visit the **Kennedy Center** for a performance of **Shear Madness**, Washington’s hilarious whodunit.

Day 4 B, D

Another full day of sightseeing with our local guide starts with a tour of the **National Cathedral** with a history dating back to President Washington. Pass by **Embassy Row** on the way to **Fort Myer**, (home to the Old Guard) for a tour of the **Horse and Caisson Barn**. **Next, it’s on to Arlington Cemetery** where we’ll witness the **changing of the guard**, tour **Lee Mansion** and visit the **Kennedy Graves**. We will finish off our tour at the **Marine Corps Memorial**.

Day 5 B, D

Today is a free day to visit one or more of the **19 Smithsonian Museums** (which are also free), or anything else you choose to do. Transportation will be provided to the majority of the museums with include History, Art, Air & Space, and Gardens. Late afternoon, see D.C from a new perspective on a narrated **sightseeing cruise**. Travel along the **Potomac River** to see the plethora of famous monuments and landmarks, with stunning views of the Jefferson Memorial, the Kennedy Center, Washington monument, Arlington Bridge & more. We finish off our stay in the DC area with dinner in historic **Old Town Alexandria, VA**

Day 6 B, D

We bid farewell Washington, D.C. with a greater understanding of this amazing area. Join your fellow travelers for activities on the bus, or enjoy watching the world go by. We are back at the **Country Inn Maumee** for the evening.

Day 7 B,
