7 Days: October 16 - 22, 2021

Day 1 B, D

Enjoy your boxed breakfast and fun on the bus as we make our way to Strongsville, Ohio and our first overnight at the Holiday Inn.

Day 2 B, D

Today we will travel to Annapolis, Maryland and enjoy a 4 night stay at the beautiful Westin Hotel located in the heart of the action in Annapolis.

Day 3 B. C

A local guide will join us for a **tour of Annapolis** and take you back to the 18th Century. The guide will lead us through the **Old Senate Chamber**, in the **Maryland State House**, where in 1783 George Washington resigned as Commander-in-Chief. Our final stop of the day will be for a **guided walking tour of the U.S. Naval Academy.** If you do not wish to do the walking tour, you can spend time in the U.S. Naval Academy Visitor Center. This afternoon, you are in for a special treat as we **sail aboard one of only a few remaining Chesapeake Bay Skipjacks, the** *Wilma Lee***. It is a member of the last commercial sailing fleet in the U.S. and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. We will finish our day at the Guinness Barrelhouse and Brewery**. Enjoy a tour talk about their history, demonstrations and a review of the small-batch room. Dinner with samples are included.

Day 4 B, D

Today we will tour the **Chesapeake Bay Maritime Museum** to learn the traditions of boat building, fishing, water fowling, and going into a 100-year old screw-pile lighthouse. Then, we will take a **"Catch of the Day" tour** to learn what it means to "follow the water" in every season on the Chesapeake through the eyes of a waterman. You will tong for oysters, pull crab pots, and hear stories of the "big guns" commercial hunters used at the turn of the 19th Century. No visit to Maryland would be complete without an incredible **Maryland Crab Feast Experience Dinner.** If you don't like crab, don't worry, there is an alternate entrée available.

Day 5 B. L. D

A local guide will join us today for a day in Baltimore. You will see significant sites including Mount Vernon Place, Washington Monument, and Edgar Allan Poe's grave. We will tour the B&O Railroad Museum which includes special Civil War era locomotives. Take a behind-the-scenes tour of the Oriole Park at Camden Yards, the Ballpark that forever changed baseball. Visit more than 15,000 specimens of aquatic life at the National Aquarium. Then, we will arrive at Fort McHenry National Monument & Shrine in time for the end of the day where you can help with folding/exchanging the flag flying above the Fort. Take in the views of the Inner Harbor and experience the Top of the World Observatory before dinner.

We will make a stop at the **Flight 93 Memorial** enroute to the Holiday Inn in Strongsville, OH.

Day 7 B

Before returning home, we will make a stop in Middlebury, Indiana for a sweet treat.
