7 Days: Oct. 23 - 29, 2021

Day 1 B, D - Enjoy a boxed breakfast as we travel through the Land of Lincoln, we'll stop for the night in Cape Girardeau, MO which is nestled along the western banks of the mighty Mississippi. Enjoy Drury's hot food & Cold beverages at the 'Kickback" Drury Plaza Cape Girardeau
