





Today we will explore all that Delevan has to offer. In 2003, Congdon Park's quiet pond and small flower garden experience an important change with an initiative by the Delavan-Darien Rotary that created what has become **Congdon Gardens**. There is a perennial garden with a large fountain as its centerpiece. It also has seven granite boulders that signify the seven continents of the world united by water. We will enjoy a guided tour of the Congdon Gardens. Now that you have worked up an appetite, we'll duck in to the **Duck Inn Supper Club**. The name, the Duck Inn, originated first during the prohibition era when the Duck Inn was a speakeasy. Patrons were to secretly "duck in" for a drink where the bartender would tell a patron to be quiet and "speak easy." (Entrée Choice due at time of reservation: Salmon Filet with Dill Sauce, Baby Back BBQ Pork Ribs, Roasted Duck or Deep Fried Shrimp. All entrees include cheese & crackers, relish tray, tossed salad, coffee, tea or milk and a Strawberry Parfait for dessert). This afternoon, we will make a stop at the **Apple Barn Orchard & Winery** which features an open orchard and farm full the seasonal fruits. The farm is situated on land that has been in the Jacobson family since 1848. The land was turned into an orchard when 40 acres were planted in 1976. The winery is a new addition that specializes in a variety of fruit wines, all made in small batches to ensure richness and quality. Next, we will **Stop and Smell the Roses.** Doug Amon, owner, built the beautiful rose gardens in memory of his whfe who passed away. He has been nurturing them since he was 70 years old, and through a little trial and error, he now has 400 rose buses and a lot of visitors each year.
