Enjoy the fall colors of Door County!

3 Days: October 15 - 17, 2023

Day 1 B, D

Enjoy a boxed breakfast as we head north to Door County. Enjoy 3 days in Door County on this narrated sightseeing tour. We will visit the **Sturgeon Bay Shipping Canal, view Bay Shipbuilding and drive past some orchards.** We will make a stop a **Door Peninsula Winery** and sample some of their delicious wines. Continuing north up the Door, we will end up at the **Rowleys Bay Resort for our 2 night stay**. The Rowleys Bay Resort is situated off the beaten path on 100 secluded acres dominating a pristine and undeveloped bay with 700 feet of Lake Michigan shoreline, making it one of the most picturesque locations in Door County. Tonight's dinner is the **Chef's choice buffet at Rowleys Bay consisting of soups, entrees, sides, desserts and all items are home-made.**

Day 2 B, L, D

Today, we will board the Ferry to Washington Island and cruise over crystal blue waters to the Island. Washington Island is a 22-square mile, year-round home to over 700 people and a destination for thousands of visitors annually. Upon arrival on Washington Island, we will start our journey and make a stop at Washington Harbor and School House Beach which is a protected harbor and the Island's original shipping port. We will learn about Washington Island's farming history at the Farm Museum. We will make a stop at the Stave Church, Door County's hidden historical treasure. The Stavkirk (Church of Staves) is based on drawings of the one built in Borgund, Norway in 1150AD. Lunch is included at Nelsen's Hall Bitter's Pub & Restaurant. Enjoy the turn of the century atmosphere and you have the opportunity to join the Bitter's Club. One last stop on Washington Island is Mann's Mercantile which offers the largest selection of gifts and souvenirs on Washington Island. We will ferry back to the mainland and stop in Ephraim at the Island Lavender Company which is located in a large historic 100 year old red barn. They feature an extensive and wide range of products made from their locally-grown lavender plants. Tonight's dinner is a real treat as you enjoy a Door County Fish Boil with narration about the history of the area and the tradition of the Door County Fish Boil by "Peter Rowley." Don't worry if you don't eat fish, there are other entrees to choose from.

Day 3 B

This morning we will stop at **Seaquist Orchards Farm Market** where they will have lots of pies, james, jellies and more to purchase. But, we will also take a tour and learn about their farm! You will have some **free time for shopping in Fish Creek** before we head to **Von Stiehl Wine**ry for some samples! Return home with colorful memories of your vacation to Door County!
