





We'll start our day with a ride up Rib Mountain on the Granite Peak Lift Chairs for unforgettable fall views. You can get off at the top and walk around to take in the amazingly colorful view. Next, we will visit the unique spot that is halfway between the Equator and the North Pole, a quarter of the way around the planet, and halfway between Greenwich Meridian and the International Date Line...and it is located right here in Wisconsin. It is the 45 x 90 Geographical Marker, proclaimed "The Center of the Northwestern World" in the early 1970's. Next, enjoy lunch and talk at Willow Springs Gardens where they are passionate about preserving history. This is a beautiful venue sitting on 40 acres and is home to buildings which have been painstakingly moved from their original location and lovingly restored. (Lunch Menu: Homemade Soup Lunch including some delicious pie). Our final stop for the day is at the Leigh Yawkey Woods Art Museum which is best known for its annual "Birds in Art" exhibition, which exhibits contemporary artistic representations of birds. The annual exhibition has been held beginning the week after LaboaDay since the museum's founding in 1976.
