After lunch you will venture into the magical **Parade Company Studio** and experience a behind-the-scenes look at America's Thanksgiving Parade, one of Motor City's oldest traditions. Learn more about the Parade's fascinating history explore the 200,000 square-foot storyland of floats and see how the award-winning artisans bring them to life. See views of homes from Motown Royalty and other Detroit celebrities such as Gladys Knight, David Ruffin, Martha Reeves, Marvin Gaye, Berry Gordy and more! Then, you will arrive for dinner at the **Motown Bistro, a Motown-themed restaurant with items of Motown history on display. Enjoy dinner while listening to Detroit Native and the first African American salesman for Motown Records, Miller London, talk about his time at Motown Records.**

Day 4 B, L, D

This morning you will head over to **Belle Isle Park**, a 985-acre island park located on the Detroit River. It is rich with natural beauty and historical and cultural resources. The park also provides spectacular views of Detroit to the North and Canada to the South. You will start by visiting the **Belle Isle Conservatory** which is the oldest continually-running conservatory in the United

States. It is divided into five distinct sections: Palm House, the Tropical House, the Cactus House, a sunken Fernery, and the Show House. Then, you will head over to the **Belle Isle Aquarium** which was designed by famed Detroit architect, Albert Kahn, and opened on August 18, 1904. It is the oldest Aquarium in the country. It features one of the largest collections of air breathing fish in the



world and they house the only known collection of all 7 species of gar in North America! We will set sail aboard the **Diamond Jack Boat for a luncheon cruise.** Enjoy a guided tour on the Detroit River. See beautiful views of the Detroit and Windsor skylines. Enjoy hearing the one-of-a-kind history of the Motor City, see interesting sights and hear sounds along the way. To complete your day, you will **tour and enjoy a private dinner at the Edsel and Eleanor Ford Estate**, a mansion located in Grosse Pointe Shores. The 20,000 square-foot house has a fine collection of original antiques and art and beautiful lakefront grounds. The house itself is a commitment to design excellence. Wander. Wonder. Explore.
