#### Day 4 B

A local guide will join us for a full ay of touring in **Montreal**. From Vieux Montreal to Quartier des Spectacles and Mount Royal, and the St. Lawrence River, history of culture collides creating a magical destination. #### Day 6 B

We will enjoy a tour at **Albert Gilles Copper**. For nearly 100 years, the Gilles family has been renowned for its metal craftsmanship. The small unique museum tells the story of copper, but also shows magnificent cooper-art. After a demonstration and guided tour, you will be given a small sheet of copper with tools, and experiment in the art of repousse. Our final stop is at **Ile d'Orleans** which celebrates Quebec's rural tradition with its gorgeous scenery stretching along the banks of the St. Lawrence River. You will enjoy a wonderful **wine tasting** in a delightful setting.

#### Day 7 B, D

Today we will make our way to **Ottawa**, the nation's capital, located on the Ottawa River. Today, we will enjoy the famous **Canadian Tulip Festival@ The Tulip Legacy Walking Tour** is a professionally guided tour through Commissioners Park, providing visitors with in-depth historical and horticultural knowledge of the different tulip varieties within the festival. **Highlights include the Queen Juliana Gift e, The Man with Two Hats historic statue and Heritage Canada's Dutch-Canadian War Brides Display.** We will overnight at the Hampton Inn in Ottawa and enjoy dinner tonight.
