We will visit the final resting place of President Lincoln, his wife, and three children before enjoying dinner at the Route 66 Motorheads Bar. Grill & Museum. Tonight, you are in for a real treat as we visit the "Route 66 Experience." See the nostalgic neon lights in the sky, learn the history of Illinois' Route 66 and more!
