Get ready to fill your stocking throughout today and tomorrow with 7 items. Our first stop will be at Carolyn's Kitchen, No Sugar Added James and Jellies. Walk through the kitchen where Carolyn and her grandchildren help her make the No Sugar Added Jams and Jellies. This popular condiment has been enjoyed by locals for several years. Carolyn sells a large variety of flavors in her shop and you have a chance to sample them all. Then, experience the historic Hoosier Buggy Shop. LaVern builds their mode of transportation from scratch or is repairing old buggies, sleds and more. He will explain how his father started the business, about powering his tools as well as sewing the interior, electrical wiring, and requirements on the buggy for safety on the roads. We'll stop at Yoder's Rag Rug Weaver and watch Mervin and his wife Phyllis, weave their special rag rugs. He explains where he gets his materials and how the long operates. Time to sit down to a traditional Amish family-style dinner. A fun and tasty experience! Tonight, we will enjoy a drive through the Lights of Joy before arriving at the Blue Gate Inn where we will overnight.

Enjoy the heart Amish-style breakfast at the hotel this morning, before our local guide joins us for another day of stuffing your stocking. We will start at Lambright Country Chimes which started as an overstock of aluminum pipping that the RV Industry no longer needed and is now a striving business with over 800 retail businesses purchasing the chimes all over the U.S. Then, we will make our way to Teaberry Wood Products, the makers of handcrafted vertical puzzles and beautiful wooden Monroe Dutcher Baskets. You will enjoy a sweet stop at the Rise n Roll Bakery & Deli which is an Amish style bakery known for preservative-free wholesome sweet treats. They bake everything fresh daily, the old-fashioned way. Next, we will learn the religious history and background of the Amish, Mennonite, and Huterite people at the Menno Hof Interpretive Center. Before departing to return home, we will enjoy a traditional Amish fundraiser lunch called a "Haystack." It is an Amish tradition to experience.
