The Museum is located in the original headquarters and music recording studio for Motown Records. We will venture into the magical Parade Company Studio and experience a behind-the-scenes look at America's Thanksgiving Parade, one of Motor City's oldest traditions. Learn more about the Parade's fascinating history, explore the 200,000 square-foot storyland of floats and see how the award-winning artisans bring them to life. Marvel at the world's largest collection of papier-mâché heads and stop by the costume

shop, where over 3,000 costumes make a colorful array of characters come to life. This afternoon, we will tour the Ford Piquette Avenue Plant – Birthplace of the Model-T. As the birthplace of the Ford Model T Car, the Ford Piquette Avenue Plan is recognized as one of the most significant automotive heritage sites in the World. And, you will see some of these vintage cars in the Parade! It rivals the likes of Macy's Thanksgiving Day Parade with large balloons, beautiful floats, vintage autos, celebrities, and SANTA! You will also see the parade's world-famous vintage, Papier-Mache heads and specialty performers in action. This is something not to be missed! The first hour of the parade is televised nationally and the second hour of the parade is televised locally. After the parade, we will depart on a guided sightseeing tour of Detroit including Campus Martius Park, Corktown, see fantastic Murals, learn the history of Detroit and see the beautiful architecture and more on this sightseeing tour.
